RULES OF THE MEETING

ONLY RED RIVER METIS CITIZENS REGISTERED AS MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL ON THE DATE OF THE MEETING WILL BE ENTITLED TO SPEAK AT THE MEETING, RUN FOR OFFICE, OR TO VOTE ON THE ISSUES RAISED.

Members/citizens that reside more than *100 kilometers* from the meeting place or who are travelling away from their residence on the day of the meeting may be able to attend via a ZOOM link. TO BE ELIGIBLE, A CITIZEN MUST REGISTER FOR ZOOM PARTICIPATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER NO LATER THAN **4:30 pm on August 16th, 2024**. The inability to create a ZOOM link, or the interruption of an established link, shall not invalidate the meeting.

Because this is a meeting to renew a Local that has been dormant, NOMINATIONS will only be accepted from the floor of the meeting on the day of the election from persons present at the meeting. Zoom participants online during the election are eligible to vote and run for office. **CITIZENS REGISTERED WITH ANOTHER LOCAL BUT WHO WISH TO JOIN THE YOUNG'S POINT LOCAL MAY TRANSFER TO THE YOUNG'S POINT LOCAL UP UNTIL THE START OF THE MEETING.**

THE CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER SHALL CONDUCT THE MEETING ACCORDING TO ROBERTS RULES OF ORDER. His decisions shall be final and binding. Winning candidates must **receive 50% of the votes cast**, not including spoiled or otherwise invalid ballots.

THE ELECTIONS SHALL TAKE PLACE IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1. CHAIRMAN
2. VICE CHAIRMAN
3. SECRETARY-TREASURER (IF ONLY 3 EXECUTIVE OFFICERS)
4. SECRETARY (IF 4 EXECUTIVE OFFICERS)
5. TREASURER (IF 4 EXECUTIVE OFFICERS)
