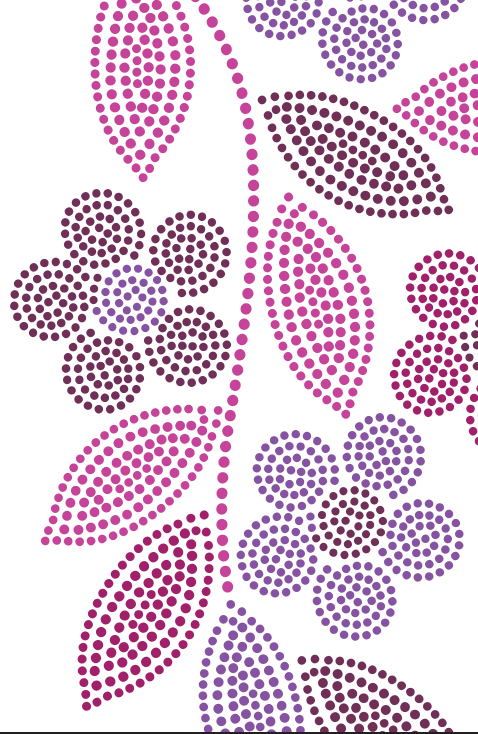


GET TESTED FOR CERVICAL CANCER



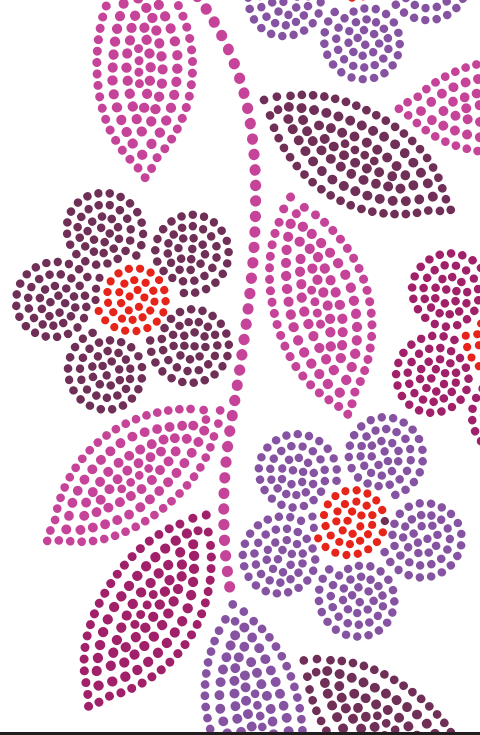
- Most women and individuals with a cervix aged 21–69 should have a Pap test every 3 years
- Vaccination for HPV can protect against cervical cancer
- Talk to your doctor about Pap tests and the HPV vaccine

GET TESTED FOR BREAST CANCER

- Mammograms can find cancer early when it's easier to treat
- Most women aged 50-74 should have a mammogram every 2 years
- Trans and non-binary people also may need regular mammograms
